

Tenants have not been announced for this speculative project, however with an industrial vacancy rate of just 4.76% in Oceanside high demand is expected.

Coomber Family Wines Tasting Room has leased 611 Mission Ave. in Downtown Oceanside.


Sadie Rose Bakery has purchased 2614 - 2616 Temple Heights and will be relocating their bakery and headquarters to Oceanside.
