

We have come a long way over the past 5 years, and collectively, we have persevered to establish and maintain a standard of excellence that we set from the very beginning. I believe we have kept pace with the ever-changing demands of opening and maintaining a small business.

To that end, I'd like to take you down memory lane ... It was 2016 and we were "gutting" the property located at 6680 Broad Street. As we studied many pages of construction plans, proposed project plans, proposed menu items, and suggested restaurant names, The Vine Café and Market came into fruition.

The City of Douglasville welcomed us as we passed inspections and made new friends in the historic downtown area. The day finally came when we opened our doors, April 26, 2017. We tried many creative ways to advertise the restaurant's offerings – Chapel Hill News, Sentinel, Vine Life Magazine, radio announcements, along with participating in several community activities from Taste of Douglasville, Christmas Parade, Restaurant Week to the infamous Stranger Things.

The community recognized and supported our efforts via the Hospitality Spirit Award, Small Business of the Year Finalist, Neighborhood Pizza Award, Chili Cookoff winner, Certificate of Impact, Main Street Pioneer of the Year, and local high school recognition.

Our Broad Street address was later renamed and renumbered, and our location transitioned from 6680 Broad Street to 12375 Veterans Memorial Highway.

Some people told us that because of our location and limited branding, there would be days when we wouldn't see a single customer. Also, that we should be prepared for all types of obstacles and even disastrous situations.

Well, 2020 hit us like a brick wall, and COVID was staring us in the face. Initially, we reduced the number of days we remained open, prayed quite a bit, and ramped up our take-out service, but we never closed.

Throughout the Pandemic, I watched the resiliency of our staff and their dedication to always doing their absolute best. For this, I commend and profusely thank each one of them. And, by the way

every day since we opened, we have always had customers.

Looking ahead, as we offer new dishes, meal kit plans, and devise creative ways to delight our customers, we continue to live up to our mission – "giving customers a healthier choice by providing high quality foods and beverages delivered with unparalleled service in a family-friendly atmosphere."
