



Food Truck FAQ's

Is there a minimum charge?

We do require a guaranteed minimum charge in order to secure supplies and staffing. Our minimum Monday thru Thursday is \$1200, Friday thru Sunday is \$1500.

How far does the food truck travel? Is there a travel fee?

Our food truck will travel up to an hour from the Twin Cities Metro. A fee of \$200 applies to locations further than 30 miles from Isanti.

Is there a time limit of service? How early do you arrive prior to the event?

Our prices are based on a 2-hour serving window. Additional serving time is \$200 per hour. We generally arrive 30 minutes prior to the start time for set-up.

Do you need electricity provided? How large is your truck?

We are able to connect to power if it is available. Otherwise, we do have a generator. It does make noise! Our truck is 26 feet long, and we must be parked on a flat surface.

Will we need a permit?

Each municipality has different requirements for mobile food units. Please check with your city to determine if a permit is needed. We are currently licensed in Anoka County and have our MDH license as well. We are not licensed in Wisconsin.

Do you provide utensils/napkins/condiments/garbage?

All the above are included in the catering package.

Do you offer vegan, vegetarian, or gluten-free options?

We do! Our rice bowls and street tacos are gluten-free, and we can make any item with veggies in lieu of meat. Our marinades and sauces are scratch-made and gluten-free.

How do we book the truck?

Submit signed contract with menu selections to guarantee the date and time. A quote will then be sent for your review. 50% payment is due within 14 days of the event. Payment can be made via check or card payment (subject to processing fee).
