

Baron's Sino Kitchen & Bar Consumer Terms and Conditions

Promotional Vouchers and Membership Products | English Edition

1. General Program Terms

1. These promotional vouchers are issued at no charge as part of the restaurant's promotional or loyalty program. They are not sold stored-value cards, are not redeemable for cash, and do not carry any residual balance after redemption.
2. All vouchers and membership benefits are valid for dine-in only unless the restaurant expressly states otherwise in writing.
3. All minimum-spend thresholds are calculated on the pre-tax food subtotal only.
4. Unless expressly stated otherwise, vouchers and membership food discounts do not apply to alcohol, tax, mandatory service charge, gratuity, third-party delivery orders, gift card purchases, private event contract charges, or separately packaged retail items.
5. Only one promotional voucher or one membership benefit may be used per table, per visit. Promotional vouchers and membership benefits may not be combined with one another or with other discounts, event menus, tasting menus, prix fixe menus, or special packages unless the restaurant expressly permits it in writing.
6. Original presentation of the card, code, QR code, or verified membership record may be required at redemption. The restaurant may refuse altered, copied, screenshot, duplicated, forged, or otherwise invalid redemption materials.
7. Vouchers may not be resold, auctioned, transferred for value, or used for commercial promotional purposes.
8. Benefits omitted before the check is closed may not be applied retroactively after payment has been completed.
9. The restaurant may amend or discontinue the program prospectively. Vouchers already issued and memberships already activated remain governed by the terms in effect on the date of issue or activation, except as required by law.
10. The restaurant may decline redemption or suspend benefits in cases of fraud, abuse, bill-splitting to evade thresholds, unauthorized transfer, resale, or other misuse inconsistent with these terms.

2.1 Lunch Invitation

- Benefit: \$10 off eligible dine-in food purchases when the pre-tax food subtotal is \$60 or more.
- Validity: 30 days from the issue date shown on the card.
- Use period: Monday through Friday lunch hours only.
- Additional terms: Single-use voucher issued at no charge; one voucher per table per visit; not valid on holidays, blackout dates, or restaurant-designated special-menu periods; no cash value and no cash back for unused value.

2.2 Return Privilege

- Benefit: \$30 off eligible dine-in food purchases when the pre-tax food subtotal is \$120 or more.
- Validity: 45 days from the issue date shown on the card.
- Use period: Sunday through Thursday only.
- Additional terms: Single-use voucher issued at no charge; one voucher per table per visit; not valid on Fridays, Saturdays, holidays, blackout dates, tasting menus, prix fixe menus, or restaurant-designated special-menu periods; no cash value and no cash back for unused value.

2.3 Chef's Invitation

- Benefit: \$50 off eligible dine-in food purchases when the pre-tax food subtotal is \$200 or more.
- Validity: 45 days from the issue date shown on the card.
- Use period: Sunday through Thursday only.
- Additional terms: Single-use voucher issued at no charge; one voucher per table per visit; not valid on Fridays, Saturdays, holidays, blackout dates, tasting menus, prix fixe menus, or restaurant-designated special-menu periods; subject to availability during unusually high-demand periods; no cash value and no cash back for unused value.

3.1 Baron's Society

- Annual membership fee: \$168.
- Membership term: 12 months from the activation date.
- Membership becomes valid only after activation in the restaurant's system.
- Benefits: 10% off eligible dine-in food purchases; priority reservation access subject to table availability and reservation policies; Peking Duck priority access subject to daily allocation, production capacity, and advance reservation requirements; one birthday dessert per membership year subject to birthday verification and dine-in celebration use; access to selected member events when offered, subject to RSVP and availability.
- Rules: Member must be present at the table to use benefits; only one membership benefit may be used per table per visit; food discount excludes alcohol, tax, mandatory service charge, gratuity, gift card purchases, private event contract charges, and selected promotional items; no automatic renewal unless separately disclosed and separately authorized; membership is non-refundable after activation except as required by law; membership is non-transferable and may not be shared with non-members.

3.2 Baron's Society Black

- Annual membership fee: \$388.
- Membership term: 12 months from the activation date.
- Membership becomes valid only after activation in the restaurant's system.
- Benefits: 12% off eligible dine-in food purchases; enhanced priority reservation access subject to availability, release schedules, and reservation policies; access to designated VIP Chef Dinner invitations or priority registration when offered; access to selected exclusive events, tastings, previews, or member-only experiences subject to availability and separate event terms; priority holiday reservation access where offered, subject to release dates, holiday capacity, menu format, and blackout restrictions.
- Rules: Member must be present at the table to use benefits; only one membership benefit may be used per table per visit; food discount excludes alcohol, tax, mandatory service charge, gratuity, gift card purchases, private event contract charges, and selected promotional items; VIP Chef Dinner and exclusive events are limited programs and may be subject to dates, menus, capacity, RSVP rules, deposits, guest limits, and other event-specific restrictions; no automatic renewal unless separately disclosed and separately authorized; membership is non-refundable after activation except as required by law; membership is non-transferable and may not be shared with non-members.

4. Reservation, Verification, and Redemption Procedures

- Guests should present the voucher or identify the membership benefit before the check is closed.
- Advance notice may be required for duck priority, birthday dessert, member events, VIP Chef Dinner, or holiday priority reservations.
- The restaurant may verify card numbers, QR codes, account records, membership identity, or reservation details before granting benefits.
- All benefits are subject to availability, operating hours, seating capacity, reservation policies, and the applicable menu format in effect at the time of booking or redemption.

5. Disputes, Errors, and Contact

- The restaurant may correct clerical, printing, coding, or obvious administrative errors in good faith.
- Consumers with questions about redemption should contact the restaurant as early as practicable and, whenever possible, before the intended date of use.
- Nothing in these terms limits rights that cannot be waived under applicable law.
