Why *KansasCity* BARBEQUE

In the late 1800s Kansas City thrived in America's heartland as an important river port, crossroads of two of the busiest railways and the terminus of numerous cattle drives. Livestock central, many "joints" like ours have made Kansas City barbeque famous - slow smoked over a variety of woods in a pit smoker, resulting in a one-of-a-kind flavor and one delicious plate of barbeque.

Our proprietors, Martin and Cindy Blair, take pride in their Kansas City heritage where Bryant's, Jack Stack, K.C. Joe's, Hayward's and Q39 still reign supreme among over a hundred barbeque places in the metro area. Burnt Ends are a Kansas City delicacy - pieces of brisket taken from the point and cooked a little longer to bring out the flavor. The American Royal hosts the worlds largest (and arguably most prestigious) barbeque restaurant contest each October.

Revered by aficionados, our meat is smoked in-house nightly. The sauce has a tomato base - tangy and not too sweet. Our rubs contain a variety of spices which help hold the meat juices while adding a little extra flavor. Side orders are made fresh daily and white bread is provided to soak up and savor any remaining sauce.

Why film blockbuster hit movie "TOP GUN" at KCBBQ?

In 1985, when the location director for Paramount Studios was downtown in search of places to film "TOP GUN" (the motorcycle scenes took place at Seaport Villiage actoss the street), he stopped in for a beer and liked the place. He brought back the director, who asked if we would be willing to close down for a day of shooting. In retrospect, it was one of our better decisions.

When the director, Tony Scott, spotted our piano, he had the script rewritten to include "Goose" (Anthony Edwards) playing and singing "Great Balls of Fire" by Jerry Lee Lewis. We had fun watching Tom Cruise, Kelly McGillis and Meg Ryan doing their scenes. A month later, the crew returned to film the final scene of the movie when "Maverick" (Cruise) and "Charlie" (McGillis) reunite as "You've Lost That Lovin' Feelin' by the Righteous Brothers played on the jukebox.
