Tasting Notes

The Lions Head Luxury Collection demonstrates boldness where you least expect it. "Panthera Chardonnay showcases the dynamism and energy of the Russian River Valley as this wine displays both a vibrant aspect of fruit and a confident oak profile. Aromas of Asian pear and bright stone fruit followed by juicy layers of lemon curd developed from malolactic fermentation and vanilla from the barrel fermentation with a flinty finish. A baseline of toasted oak introduces hints of crème brûlée, which are complemented by a signature backbone of acidity nurtured on the Sonoma Coast." –Stephanie Pope, Winemaker

Tasting Notes:

Ptujška Klet winery cellars have been used for storing and aging wine since 1239. Located under the historic town of Ptuj founded by the Romans, the Ptuj Cellar is one of the oldest in Europe. A perfect balance between freshness and depth! Aromas of grapefruit & tomato leaf. On the palate, plenty of texture and minerality. Bright acidity balanced with some weight and creaminess and a long finish.

YLERRA 'PEPE YLLERA' - RED BLEND 2020

Tasting Notes

The 2020 Pepe Yllera is a 100% Tempranillo from Ribera del Duero. Garnet-red in color. The nose reveals sour cherry, wild herbs, bay leaf and faint undertones of undergrowth. The palate is dry and rich, with tannins that provide buoyant support to a precise, oaky presence that lingers at the back of the throat.

DAOU CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2022

Tasting Notes:

The 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon is impossible to ignore. Violet pastille and sweet spice complement a burst of crushed blackberries and cherries. Silken and seamless, it swirls across the palate with an energetic mix of ripe wild berries and citrus, all motivated by a core of vibrant acidity. While gently tannic, the 2022 remains fresh and lively throughout, leaving a tart blackberry tinge that carries on.

Special Notes:

The wine was matured for 10 months in 50% new French oak.

Pair with bresaola, rich, salty, aged Parmigiano, caramelized roasted vegetables, bittersweet dark chocolate, and crusty bread and a few drops of quality olive oil.
