

## Eating News in Miami: October '25

Nearly a century after first opening its doors, a beloved neighborhood restaurant made its return to Palmetto Bay. [\*\*Old Cutler Inn\*\*](#), the modern reimagining of the iconic Snowden's restaurant, is open for dinner on August 23rd at 16800 Old Cutler Road – across from the historic Deering Estate.

Originally located just down the road at 7271 SW 168th Street, Snowden's was Palmetto Bay's own version of "Cheers," a well-loved spot where everyone knew each other's names. Founded in the 1920s by George Snowden on land acquired from Charles Deering, the original inn became known for its warm, welcoming atmosphere and crowd-pleasing comfort food.

Now, real estate investor and developer Drew Dorsy of Bindor, along with seasoned hospitality operator Benjamin Pascarella, founder of Ciotola Restaurant Group, are bringing this local institution back to life in a completely reimagined space, formerly occupied by a BB&T bank.

The new Old Cutler Inn features a 4,500-square-foot versatile indoor-outdoor dining venue with 125 seats. The space is an ode to American vibrancy, showcasing Palmetto Bay's historic past thr

The dinner menu celebrates wood-fired American fusion classics with a modern twist. Guests can expect dishes like Wahoo Fish Dip, a Korean BBQ Short Rib, Flatiron Steak Frites, and handcrafted oven-baked sourdough flatbread made with locally sourced ingredients. Rotating desserts add a sweet finale to the meal. Every dish is meant for sharing – sparking conversation and creating moments worth savoring again and again.

Much like the evening program, the indoor and outdoor bar will serve a menu of creative craft cocktails. The restaurant is open Sunday through Thursdays from 4 p.m. to 10 p.m. and Fridays and Saturdays from 4-11 p.m. Happy hour is Monday through Friday from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. Breakfast and lunch will be debuting in the near future.
